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Al Nayzak is Palestinian non-profit, non- partisan, Jerusalemite and unique initiative that looks for young talents in science, technology, engineering, and math(STEM), and plants an ambitious vision in the hearts

of our community: "To develop, root, and reinforce a new culture that embraces science, and to announce this culture among Palestinian youth so that their competence in productive applied sciences could provide them with better economic opportunities that would lead to their future prosperity."

Al Nayzak's approach is to make scientific-thinking skills become an inherent part of the lives of Palestinian people. In order to do this, it applies empirical tools to help individuals acquire thinking skills and relate them to genuine savoir-faire and technology.

In order to achieve its mission, the organization has adopted a series of chronically conducted annual programs that target various age groups to incubate talented people from an early age. There are also a number of complementary projects to convey a message of science and knowledge to all segments of the society.

Crowning its series of achievements and a 10 years parade for innovation, the organization inaugurated in 2013 the first Science and Technology House in Palestine, where visitors enjoy hands on activities all dedicated to create a culture of scientific thinking and as a nuclear to establishing the National Science and Technology Museum in Palestine. The Science House receives around 15 thousand visitors annually.

Al Nayzak serves all Palestinian areas through its network of offices in Jerusalem, Ramallah, Gaza, Hebron, and Nablus, as well as in the Science and Technology House in the Old City of Birzeit.



Badir program is a pioneer program that targets Palestinian school students in the eighth and ninth grades, and works to build their capacity in the areas of critical and creative thinking, research skills, communication, teamwork, advocacy and awareness, through the design and implementation of community-based initiatives and pioneer projects based on scientific grounds of observation and problems

identification and proposing positive solutions for these problems.

Badir program enables participant adolescents to face the challenges they encounter and enhance their sense of belonging to make societal and scientific environmental change through the development of their skills and building their capacity so they can become future leaders. In addition, the program works to keep up with the growing interest in modern technology and qualifying the adolescents and teachers to use and employ them in the right way and in the benefit of the educational path.

The program works to train students on the previous skills in the first phase and then supporting them in the proposal, design, and implementation of innovative initiatives and pioneer projects to provide solutions to the problems and phenomena observed by the adolescents themselves, based on the fundamentals of scientific research and critical and creative thinking to create positive change in their communities.

In the first year of the implementation of the program 2014/2015; 380 Initiative has been implemented by about 13,000 adolescents distributed on 380 classes from 130 schools belonging to the Ministry of Education and Higher Education and the Palestinian Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees - UNRWA. The initiatives varied in subjects between social, scientific, environmental, and humanitarian, and targeted different categories of the society, but they all were based on scientific research and a long path of teamwork among the members of the class group to get out the best ideas. At the end of the program the best 41 implemented initiatives were honoured after arbitration in different areas by scientific committees according to precise and specific criteria.



From the Young Researcher to Badir







Badir Program came as an extension of the Young Researcher program that has been implemented by Al Nayzak Foundation on an annual basis over eight years, since 2006. During the past years the program achieved a great success incorporating more than 5,000 adolescents (males and females) from different ten Palestinian directorates in the West Bank and Gaza Strip, And development of their scientific research skills and promoting their leading role in bringing positive change in their communities and research in different issues of concern to them and then spreading awareness about these issues employing innovative and unconventional means..

Additionally, 24 booklets were published, they included adolescents' research summary in the scientific and social different subjects. The booklets were distributed to national schools to share their results and benefit others. Adolescents have also produced short videos, radio spots, educational games, and computerized applications and others...


The impact of the program has spread to tens of thousands of children and adolescents, teachers, parents and community members directly and indirectly, through the participation in workshops and campaigns to raise awareness and various scientific and social initiatives that have been implemented by the adolescents themselves over the past years. As a result of the success of the program and assessment of its activities after eight years, there was a need to expand the program and restructure it to include a larger number of adolescents and reach wider areas.

Starting from the academic year 2014/2015 Badir program was launched in its new look in West Bank and Gaza Strip, with the participation of about 13,000 students from 130 school belonging to the Ministry of Education and Higher Education and the Palestinian Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees - UNRWA and in partnership with the United Nations Children's Fund - UNICEF. Participating schools were distributed on 12 different Directorates in West Bank, Jerusalem and the Gaza Strip, including Jerusalem, sub-Jerusalem, Nablus, South Nablus, Bethlehem, Hebron, north of Hebron, South Hebron, west of Gaza, east of Gaza, east of Khan Younis, and northern Gaza


Badir

A joint committee, From Al Nayzak Foundation and the Ministry of Education and Higher Education and UNRWA, managed to choose 130 schools to participate in Badir program in its first year. The schools' participation came through three class groups and a supervising teacher in each school. In addition to volunteer, facilitator, and trainer to oversee the work during the program period.


The following chart shows the number of participating schools in Badir program, disaggregated by directorates:




In the year 2014/2015 the ratio between participating female adolescents and male adolescents increased, the following chart shows the proportion of females compared to males of those who participated in the program:



By the end of the program 380 Initiatives were implemented in all of the participating directorates according to the following distribution



After judging of the initiatives through local exhibitions held in the different directorates, the judging committees chose the 41 Initiatives according to specific criteria that considers originality, creativity and research skills, teamwork and others. The following chart shows the number of participating initiatives compared to the number of winning ones in each Directorate.





After passing the regional assessment phase for the initiatives, 41 distinguished initiatives were nominated to participate in the National exhibition, the initiatives varied in several scientific, social, humanitarian and environmental fields and others:



Our Heritage In Our Hands

Al-Rawda Al-Haditha Al-Islamiya Girls School - Jerusalem Directorate

The initiative is centered on the idea of reviving the Palestinian heritage through the use of Palestinian traditional embroidery for the school uniform belts. The idea started from students of the eighth grade (b), and then it was met with great demand from the school administration staff, where the administration decided to adopt this belt in school uniforms for all students of the school starting from next year, to be the first school to revive Palestinian embroidery in school uniforms and by the hands of its students.



Recycle, Play, Learn

Al-Fatat Al-Shamelah Secondary School - Jerusalem Directorate

Producing educational toys and games for children by recycling consumed raw materials. The students produced several games including a game for learning the multiplication table, and a cuneiform painting to illustrate mathematical concepts, and a fan from the old memory drive. Also, they managed to charge an iPod using acids from fruits and vegetables, and they took advantage of an old computer keyboard to learn how to write in English, and counting using pulses. The adolescents aim through these games to encourage teachers on the learning by playing approach. This initiative has an advantage that it's environment friendly, and requires no financial resources, as it recycles existing resources.



Granny And Her Song

Shuafat Refugee Camp Girls Elementary First School - Jerusalem Directorate

The initiative aims to collect the legacy of old songs to educate the new and future generations about the traditional songs that were sung by our grandmothers at weddings and events. At the beginning, the adolescent girls gathered songs from the grandparents and the elderly, and then typed and printed a booklet containing songs known to the grandmothers, whether Palestinian or from neighboring countries. In the second phase a group of students who possess beautiful voices were selected to simply spontaneously record some of the songs using the devices available in hand, and then a CD containing grandparents' songs by grandchildren voices was produced. The initiative will not stop here, the adolescent girls are determined in the next stage to produce a separate booklet and CD for each Palestinian city and village.



The Four Quarters

Al-Jeel Al-Jadeed Elementary Boys School - Jerusalem Directorate

A Jerusalemite initiative with excellence, has been implemented by the adolescents of the eighth grade in Al-Jeel Al-Jadeed school with purpose of introducing the four quarters of the old city of Jerusalem; Islamic, Christian, Armenian and Jewish. The adolescents reproduced the traditional "Snake and ladder "game to focus on the subject of the initiative by providing interesting information through questions about the four quarters.



Your Health In Your Food

Abu Dees Mixed Elementary School - Sub-Jerusalem Directorate

The students took the initiative to develop solutions to the problem of spoiled food, by starting to communicate with the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Economy and receiving a training course presented by a health inspector about spoiled food. The initiative included a tour with the Ministry of Economy to detect spoiled food, and the distribution of brochures on spoiled food and their harm on the society. In addition, lectures and meetings were held at the school about the harmful effects of spoiled food and the proper way to replace manufactured foods with homemade food, and how to identify the date of production and expiry, moreover, doctors and specialists in health were hosted to talk about the subject. The initiative was concluded with organizing a healthy food event inside the school.



Towards A Healthy, Beautiful & Safe Environment

Abu Dees Secondary Girls School - Sub - Jerusalem Directorate

This initiative consists of two parts; the first part raised the problem of trucks that expose students to danger while coming out from the school, the solution was for a police patrol to work for an hour during the departure of the students from the school. The second part revolves around the beauty of the town of Abu Dees, starting from the outer wall of the school, where the adolescents painted it and collected the trash left by parents and recycled it to form beautiful artistic pieces.



Food (Vegetables On The Roof)

Anata Boys High Elementary School - Sub-Jerusalem Directorate

In the town of Anata the adolescents long to see the green nature, and because of the lack of agricultural land and the intense construction, the adolescents though about some solutions to increase the green space in their city, and they put many proposals. The initiative is about planting rooftops, where the pioneers chose one roof of a house in the city, and worked to clean and prepare and paint the roof with the help of an agricultural engineer, and then many of the plants and trees were planted. Through the initiative an empty roof was transformed to a beautiful scenery place, and a source for some types of vegetables, fruits and herbs.



Clean Desk

Omar Jamal Al-Masri Girls Elementary School - Nablus Directorate

The idea of clean desk initiative emerged after noticing the large space that school desks occupy from the classroom hall, which causes troubles for students as they move in the classroom, especially when they want to throw the remnants of the eraser and sharpener. The students searched for solutions to this problem and finally reached one; that is to put a hole in the desk to unload the waste. To make things more innovative, the students added pedals under the desk to stimulate students and renew the circulatory system they have. The electric power generated by moving the pedals is used in the lighting process.



One Voice

Al-Haj Ali Al-Tibi Girls Secondary School - Nablus Directorate

It's usually difficult for the adolescent girls to communicate with their deaf and dumb peers. The students decided to challenge this problem by learning sign language in the Palestinian Red Crescent Society, and integration of their deaf and dumb peers in theatrical work using sign language.



We're With You.. Don't Worry

Yasser Arafat Girls Elementary School - Nablus Directorate

Decorating and establishment of stories and games corner for the Children in the Cancer Division that is a part of Al-Najah Hospital in Nablus. The students hanged decorations and established games and stories corner for the benefit of the visitors and resident children of the division. The Students distributed gifts to the children with kidney and cancer diseases and other children in hospitalization, in addition to conducting a musical session for children at the end of the day.



I Read.. I Exist

Al-Burtughaliya Girls Elementary School, Beit Furik - Nablus Directorate

The initiative addresses the problem of the demise of reading culture through reading clubs and reading news bulletin, The Initiative activities included the assignment of reading Ambassador. The initiative also worked on a printed book containing quotations from other books and literary works of some of the students, where every student has left a quote from a book she read and wanted to share with readers. The book aims at encouraging new readers to read some topics easily and simply, and it also gives an opportunity for talented students to publish literary writings of their own. Within the activities of the initiative a silent theatrical was designed to promote the initiative and to emphasize the importance of reading as an acquired habit.



Crowd

Nablus Boys Elementary School - Nablus Directorate

Recently the preference of Israeli products culture spread widely, and the number of people wanting to buy these goods compared to Palestinian goods increased. From here the adolescents decided to find appropriate means that consist with the community culture to limit the phenomenon, they chose the most crowded place in the city of Nablus, which is the central mall to do a silent play, which included several ideas calling for a boycott of Israeli goods.



From Us And Within Us (Autism Spectrum)

Al-Haj Ma'zouz Al- Masri Girls Elementary- Nablus Directorate

Because autistic children are integral part of the society, research on the disease or disorder was conducted and statistics were collected while leaflets were distributed to children parents. To learn more about this disorder the students have visited "sanad" center and arranged to visit the center during the World Day for autism. The students prepared an entertainment program for children based on scientific background after consulting specialists, the day has been implemented with great success, and the students decided to arrange alike days in the future.



Activating The Classroom Garden

Ibn - Qutaiba Boys Elementary School- Nablus Directorate

Rearranging the school garden to fit the establishment of classroom hall for students in terms of provision of public safety conditions in order to attract students to enjoy the learning process and activate the green environment. During the initiative some classes were given for students to utilize the garden hall to alleviate the overcrowding of students in classrooms.



Nothing Is Sweeter Than Their Stories

Jimma'een Girls Secondary- South Nablus Directorate

The students began the idea of an "elderly forum", where old people meet once or twice a week. The initiative aims to teach the elderly how to use modern technology in addition to reading and writing instruction. The students did this task by themselves. The idea evolved into the experience exchange between the two parties, the elderly began to teach the students some skills such as embroidery, and knitting and this in turn made the elderly feel beneficial and positive members in the community.



What Do You Know About Your Country?

Agraba Girls Elementary School - South Nablus Directorate

Aqraba is well-known for the existence of many ruins; however these ruins don't get any attention from any party in the area. Because they believe in the importance and of preservation of such history, the adolescent girls used the services of an expert to study the ruins and identify each of it, later on the students distributed the roles and began introducing the ruins to the visitors and organizing tours.



The Birth Of A Dream

Al-Awdah Girls Elementary School - Bethlehem Directorate

The birth of a dream is an initiative seeking to improve the houses of poor families in which the basic components are not available to live. One house of a needy family has been selected and renovated, and some damages in it were repaired, after collecting aids from the local community.



A Child's Smile Brings Us Life Back

Beit Jala Girls Mixed Elementary School - Bethlehem Directorate

"Do good, for it is the only thing that does not die when you do,"
This was the slogan of the initiative which aimed at putting one
smile at least on the faces of orphaned children. The students
collect in-kind aids and organized a joy and fun ceremony for
more than 100 orphans with their relatives, and they distributed
gifts to them. Students aspire to continue the initiative after
the end of the program; they hope to distribute gifts a few days
before holidays and before the beginning of a new school year.



Think Of Others

Al-Khulafa' Al-Rashidoon Boys Elementary School - Bethlehem Directorate

While the proportion of poor people has gradually increased in Palestine, and the excessive indulgence in food manifestations increased as well, either individually, or by restaurants that get rid of food in an inappropriate way that doesn't comply with our culture, this initiative came to collect the good food and re-package and submit it to some needy families in Bethlehem area. The adolescents communicated with a number of restaurants in the city, who in turn were impressed by the idea and contributed to the implementation.



Today's Readers .. Tomorrow's Pioneers

Beit Jala Girls Secondary - Bethlehem Directorate

Due to the lack of appetite for reading in the society, especially among the adolescents, the students suggested to collect books and open the doors for the local community and interested institutions to donate as well, before opening of a library in the village of "Walaja", which suffer from the siege of the apartheid wall. With their efforts and the efforts of their partners in the initiative, they were able to get a room from the Municipal Council of Al Walaja village and the Ansar center, and they have established a library for the people of the region there, and provided more than 400 books to the library after it was opened.



The Song "Where Is My Mind"

Al-Duhaisha Girls Elementary School - Bethlehem Directorate

Recently drug addiction rate increased and spread in the Palestinian territories, the reason could be the lack of awareness about its risks in the society, especially among young people. The adolescents initiative aimed to launch a comprehensive awareness campaign about the harmful effects of drug addiction, through the song "Where is my mind" and a video clip that was made for the song, in addition to organizing awareness campaign about drug addiction, and drawing a mural about the dangers of drug addiction.



Hydroponics

Al-Khader Girls Elementary School - Bethlehem Directorate

The initiative aims to exploit the vast untapped areas in the vicinity of the school, through the application of new and innovative technology in agriculture; hydroponics mechanism, which is characterized by an increase of the proportion of the growth of plants. The students installed the system on the roof of the school and planted lettuce, and the result was more than 50 plants. The Students are seeking in the coming days to expand the initiative to include a larger portion of the roof of the school, and to produce other types of plants.



A Tour And A Story

Nusseibah Almazinyah Girls Elementary School - Hebron Directorate

The idea of the initiative came from the lack of knowledge of many of the residents of Hebron about the city's history and its ruins, the idea of the initiative was to carry out tours to many of the sites and introducing them, in addition to the production of introductory videos about Hebron, to serve as a tour guide for the city residents and visitors.



Popular Health Food

Hassan Ibn Thabit Girls Secondary School - Hebron Directorate

The initiative incorporated a set of ideas in its content, so it raised awareness about the popular healthy food that has many health benefits that do not exist in other foods through a series of awareness activities.



My School Is My Responsibility

Al-Thahreyah Boys Elementary School - South Hebron Directorate

Improving the school environment by planting trees at the school entrance, and improving health facilities, and encouraging students on community work through their participation in the development of their school, and increasing their sense of responsibility.



Enhanced Health Services' Room

Al-Rayheya Girls Secondary School- South Of Hebron Directorate

Establishment and management of a health clinic that serves Al-Rayheya people as well as Al-Fawwar camp. The clinic becomes functional in the evening where there is a group of doctors and specialists, thus citizens won't bother to go to clinics in other areas.



Let Us Change Our Behavior

Ishbilyah Girls Elementary School - South Hebron Directorate

The Initiative seeks to change the behavior of citizens in Al-Thahriya in different walks of life, such as commitment to traffic laws and maintaining hygiene, especially in the downtown area near the school, where there are many stalls and streets.



Martyrs Park

Shuhada' Yatta Girls Secondary Shool- South Hebron Directorate

The initiative is about the establishment of a park next to the school which is considered an outlet for the students of the school during school hours, as well as residents of the area who can attend the park all day. The adolescent girls invested in a land near the school to achieve common interest to the local community and school students.



Your Clothes.. your reward and Others' Shade

Al-Fawwar First Girls Elementary School- South Hebron Directorate

The adolescent girls learnt knitting wool, and then produced some textiles which they displayed and sold through a handcrafts exhibition. The adolescent girls invested the money they got to install an umbrella of the students and to help students in need.



Math Is Fun!

Zahrat AL Mada'en Girls Elementary School- North Hebron Directorate

Designing a number of educational aids in the form of fun and easy games to facilitate the learning of mathematics for elementary school students. The students also taught the parents how to use these games and educational aids, so that they can teach their children math in simple and easy way.



Even Half A Date

Dura First Girls Elementary School - South Hebron Directorate

The idea of the initiative is to help the poor in Dura through the collection and distribution of gifts to the needy campaigns through a variety of food packages containing basic needs. The initiative also works to promote and increase the giving culture periodically.



Will Defeats Disability

Al-Majdal Girls High School - East Gaza Directorate


This initiative aims to spread the culture of learning the language of the deaf between the adolescents to integrate deaf children in the community. The students took the initiative to learn sign language and teaching it to more than 450 students from the school to facilitate communication with deaf people and participation of some events in the deaf school.



With Us The Captain's Ship Is Safe

Ain Jalout Girls Elementary School (A)- East Gaza Directorate


Helping fishermen who have boats that are not equipped with high technologies, by creating a simple device that has a safety alarm. The device works by measuring the loads in the boat and when there is excessive load the device turns on automatically and alerts the captain to the presence of overload that may lead to sinking of the boat, the fisherman attempts to alleviate the loads accordingly.



Last Winter Days

Al-Sayyedah Roqqayya Elementary School - West Gaza Directorate

The initiative was about paving the school street with soft gravel as a solution to the mud that is formed on the street in the winter. A petition to the municipality was signed by neighborhood residents as a complaint to draw attention to the seriousness of the problem.



With Your Efforts The Difference Will Appear

Al-Neel Boys Elementary School- West Gaza Directorate

An abandoned land which used to be a garbage dump was transformed into a large football field, the land was bulldozed and made flat, and beams for football were installed. The initiative also included the formation of sports teams in the neighborhood and organizing games and events.



Comfort In The Break

Alsawafeer Boys Elementary School - West Gaza Directorate

An Initiative that aims to find a solution for the suffering of the students in the schools due to lack of seats to sit in the school yard. The adolescents thought about exploiting old worn chairs and tables and re-manufacturing them to produce chairs to be used for sitting in the school yard.



The Young Cop

Dalia Al-Karmel Girls Elementary – East Khan Younis Directorate

Awareness initiative to alleviate the problem of traffic accidents that lead to the loss of a family member or causing disability, and which result from a lack of attention and high speed, especially in the areas near the highways. The adolescents designed publications that urge drivers to lower the speed and increase their attention to the roads, additionally they prepared traffic signs like signboards and worn police uniforms in collaboration with one of the police stations.



For Our Safety

Ibn Al-Nafees Boys Elementary School – East Khan-Younis

Within this initiative a public health clinic garden in Alzenah area, was planted, by improving the public clinic's environment and planting trees and plants and the provision of special health facilities.



Reading Is Life

Khalil Awaida Girls Preparatory School - North Gaza Directorate

The students took the initiative to spared the reading culture in their area and encourage everyone to read, through establishing a small library in the region, and collecting books in cooperation with the local committee who promised to follow up on the library and attempt to develop it



Sound Mind In Sound Body

Beit Hanoun Boys Preparatory School (A) - North Gaza Directorate

Students suffer due to the lack of safe playgrounds, what encouraged the adolescents to search for a land and prepare it by themselves to become a proper and safe playground



With Education .. Our Lives Are Better

Beit Hanoun Boys Preparatory School (C) – North Gaza Directorate

Due to the increase of school students drop outs, the adolescents took the initiative to educate their peers towards this issue, they looked for the reasons behind the drop out and attempted to solve the problem by meeting some parents and organizing competitions for the students to come up with the best educational summaries and provide them for the weak students.
